


Startups community in Kaunas

- fintech and marketing po 5,9%







Foreign Direct Investments. Kaunas







Average salary (post-tax) in Kaunas city, EUR*








Kaunas Free Economic Zone: the location & incentives

The 534 ha territory of Kaunas Free Economic Zone (FEZ) is located near Kaunas City, near the Kaunas International Airport, near roads A1 and A6.

- 12-13,5 EUR/sqm (A class).







Fully operating network – 2026.

Kaunas – the busiest spot in the network.

2 lane – for commuting (up to 249 km/h).

Goal: to create a regional innovation hub.








Kaunas European Capital of Culture 2022






Dynamics of Inbound Tourism*
