Current MRO hub size in Kaunas



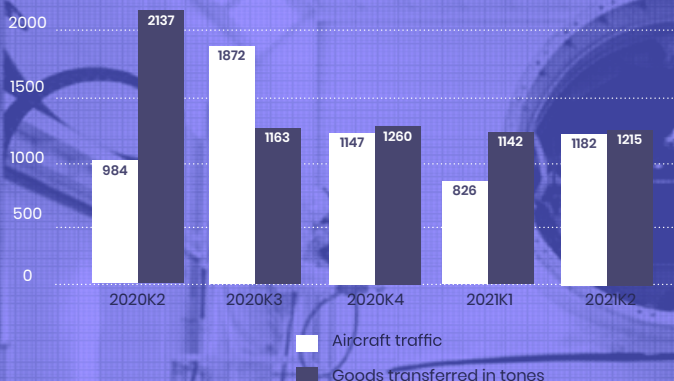

INFRASTRUCTURE AND KAUNAS AIRPORT



- ✓ The runway of Kaunas Airport is the longest in Lithuania (3,250 m) and is suited for all large aircrafts.
- ✓ In 2020, the airport was renovated to improve MRO (aircraft repair) infrastructure at Kaunas Airport. An additional apron of 15,000 m² has been built.
- ✓ Kaunas airport borders Kaunas Free Economic Zone (FEZ), offering tax incentives and land plots prepared by the plug and play principle, open for MRO companies.
- ✓ Both Kaunas airport and Kaunas FEZ are located next to the intersection of the main regional highways and railroads passing through the Baltics.

Aircraft Traffic and Goods Transferred in Kaunas Airport



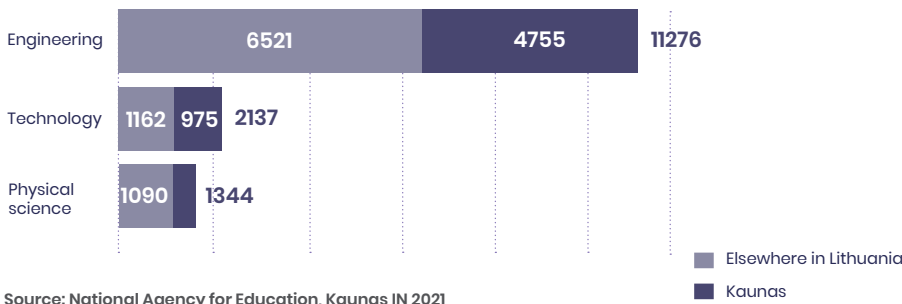
Estimated total yearly costs of renting and maintaining a 15 000 m² industrial space for MRO in euros



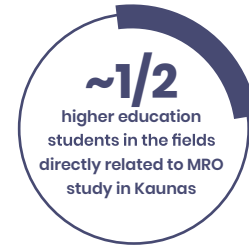

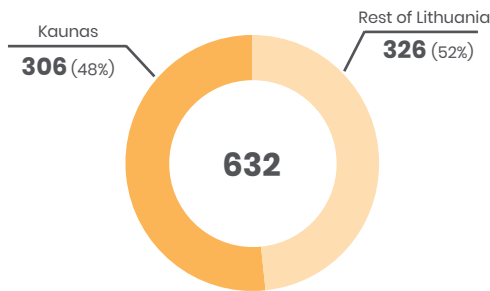
Students in fields related to MRO

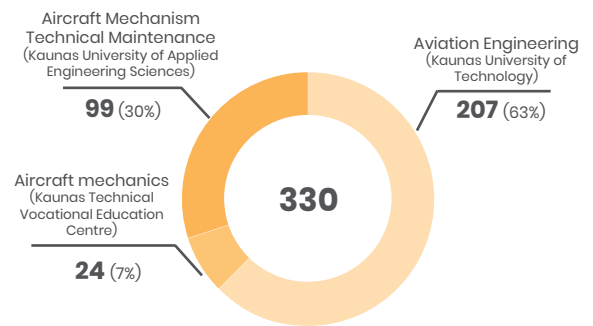


Students in programs directly related to aviation and MRO, Lithuania
